About the Foundation

The Phi Sigma Rho Foundation, founded in 2005, is one of the newest Greek Foundations for women. The Foundation exists to fund programs that provide professional, educational, philanthropic, and leadership development opportunities for the members and friends of Phi Sigma Rho Sorority.

The Foundation carries out its mission through granting money to the Phi Sigma Rho So-

rority and awarding scholarships. Scholarships based upon leadership and merit are available to actives and alumnae currently pursuing an accredited degree program. The Phi Sigma Rho Foundation is an IRS-recognized nonprofit entity. The Foundation has received tax-exempt status under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, as of March 2005. Therefore, all donations to the Foundation are tax deductible.

I sincerely thank you for your donation to the Foundation Merit Scholarship. My name is Ameé Salois and I will be finishing my Bachelor of Science degree in Physics and English after this 5th year at the University of Arkansas. This scholarship is a great help for me in my pursuit of this degree and also my career goals as an Astronomy Educator.

In my time at the University of Arkansas Phi Sigma Rho has been such a moving force behind my pursuits. The sorority has been a constant support to me in a male-dominated field and has introduced me to some of the ladies that I have become closest to throughout college. I hope to repay this scholarship in the future by being an active alumni and encouraging fellow sisters in their endeavors.

Outside of Phi Sigma Rho, this scholarship has only enhanced my drive

to pursue science education as an Astronomy Educator. Recently, I have completed an internship at the Smithsonian, National Air and Space Museum (NASM) as an Astronomy Educator. There I was able to interact with visitors on a daily basis to not only teach them about Astronomy, but also to get them excited about it. I participated in the Public **Observatory Project (POP)** which brings an astronomical observatory to the people rather than asking the people to come to the observatory. This is a fabulous project which my supervisor, Katie Moore, brought to light through a National Science Foundation (NSF) Grant. This summer I was even placed in charge of the observatory for Astronomy Night on the Mall while my supervisor was away. During this night I was able to introduce more than 300 visitors to views of the Moon, Saturn, and even

Albireo, a binary star. It was such a thrilling experience for me and has solidified my aspirations. After this year I will graduate from the University of Arkansas and pursue a position at a science center, museum, or national or state park as an Astronomy Educator. I will also be pursuing a Master's degree in Museum Education, Museum Studies, Science Education, or Science Writing. There is a lot to do but it is all being made possible with your help!
